## Get Ready for Winter

- Order a Furnace Maintenance Check-Up (888.737.7070)
- Change Air Filters
- Clean landscaping debris and lawn furniture away from the outside air conditioning condensing unit
- Use a “Water Power Nozzle” to clean the condensing unit and the surrounding area

### PEST TIPS...Crickets

- Cricket outbreaks are one of the most predictable pest events of the year in most areas of Texas. Late summer and fall are when adult crickets become especially abundant around homes and buildings.
- Outdoor lighting is the most important single cause of severe cricket infestations. Homes that are brightly lit at night are the most likely to attract the largest number of crickets. Reducing outdoor lighting is the first and most important step in a cricket control program.
- All potential sites of entry for crickets should be caulked or sealed. Sites include weep holes, soffits along the eaves of the home, windows or garage doors.
- Steel or brass wool may be stuffed in weep holes as temporary insect barriers, while allowing continued air circulation.
